Fire Warden Course

Duration: 3 Hours without live fire experience or 3 ½ with live fire experience.

A short break is taken part way through the training and should be included on top of the course time.

- Role of the fire warden
- Fire Warden Video
- Evacuation procedures
- Practical use of fire extinguishers on live fires.
- A number of training videos are used to reinforce fire safety messages and the use of fire extinguishers.
